





# **How To Maintain Your New RV**

As we near the summer months and RV season gets into full swing, it is important to remember that it is important to do regular maintenance on your new RV. Maintaining your RV properly is crucial for ensuring its longevity, performance, and safety. Here are some tips and tricks to keep your adventures going!

# **Safety**

Number one, before you hit the road, is safety. Ensure that fire extinguishers are charged and are within expiration dates. Test and replace batteries for your carbon monoxide & smoke detectors. Finally, always have a fully stocked and up-to-date first aid kit in your RV.

### **Exterior Maintenance**

Exterior maintenance is extremely important in RV maintenance. Roof sealing & inspection is an important step to maintaining the integrity of your RV. Check the roof for cracks, leaks, or damaged seals every three months. Clean the roof and apply a protective coating. Second, inspect seals & seams on windows, doors & storage compartments. Replace or reseal as needed to prevent water intrusion. If your RV has an awning, keep the awning clean and dry to prevent mold or mildew. Always inspect for tears or any other damage. Finally, wash and wax your RV regularly to protect it from UV rays, dirt & oxidation.





#### **Tires**

Since you'll be putting miles on the RV it is important to do regular tire maintenance. Pressure check the tires before each trip and inflate to the manufacturer's recommended PSI. Rotate tires regularly to ensure even wear. Additionally, check for signs of cracks, uneven wear, or damage. Replace tires as needed and always have a spare.

## **Plumbing System**

If your RV has a plumbing system, it is important to drain and flush the water heater tank to remove sediment. Check the anode rod (if applicable) and replace it when worn. Here in the Pacific Northwest, we can get some pretty cold weather, so always properly winterize the plumbing system to prevent freezing and damage. Once the summer hits, inspect all water lines, fittings, and the pump for leaks and do this regularly throughout the season.

## **Electrical System**

Always check your RV's electrical system before the start of each journey. Check the battery, clean terminals, and charge batteries regularly. Replace the batteries when needed. If you have solar panels on your new RV, clean and inspect panels for efficiency. Test all electrical outlets within and outside the RV to ensure connections are working properly. If you have a generator, conduct regular maintenance on it as well. If you need it when your power is down, it is best to make sure that it works properly.

# **Propane System**

Maintain your propane system regularly as well. Check for leaks by using a soapy water solution to check propane connections. Test the regulator to ensure proper operation. Finally, inspect and clean propane powered appliances like stoves, refrigerators & furnaces.

#### **HVAC & Interior**

If you want a comfortable experience, it is important to maintain the interior of your RV as well. Regularly maintain your HVAC system by cleaning or replacing air filters and inspecting ducts for obstructions. Clean and lubricate slide-outs, if applicable, to prevent wear and to ensure smooth operation. Additionally, inspect cabinetry, furniture and flooring for wear or damage. Regular cleaning and maintenance can help prevent major wear and tear to your RV.

# **Engine & Drivetrain Maintenance**

If you own a new Motorhome, just like your daily driver, it is important to follow regular maintenance schedules. Make sure to get regular oil changes, check fluids and top of coolant, brake fluid, and transmission fluid regularly. Inspect belts & hoses for signs of wear or cracking, always replace as needed. Additionally, check your braking system, inspect & replace brake pads or shoes when worn. For towed RVs, ensure the brake controller is properly calibrated & functioning.

## Moisture

When the summer season comes to a close and its time to store your RV, it is important to consider moisture control. If your unit does not have built-in moisture control, use a dehumidifier or moisture absorbers to prevent mold and mildew. Seal openings and use deterrents to keep out pests. Battery storage is the final step to maintaining your RV while in storage, disconnect or remove batteries to prevent drainage during long-term storage.

In summary, keep a schedmaintenance ule to ensure that all maintenance is done regularly and on time. Always refer to your owners manual for any additional information and keep it handy throughout the summer months. Finally, remember to be safe & have fun in your adventures by having the proper equipment, inspections, and maintenance.

# Which RV Type Fits Your Lifestyle?

Vacations are a great way to unwind and spend quality family time. While most working men and women take one or two vacations a year, an RV owner may take a "vacation" every weekend! Be sure you get the right RV for your needs. Here is a breakdown of the differences, and types of RVs in the 2023 market.

#### **CLASS A**



Class A Motorhome

This class of motorhome is the largest. Many people who purchase a Class A intend to travel full time. Slide outs can expand the living area to the point it is like an apartment. Many Class A's have a washer/dryer, fireplace, audio systems etc.

Class A motorhomes can either be diesel or gas. Diesel models are typically more expensive, but the fuel economy and power outweigh that.

# **CLASS B**

Class B RVs are really gaining in popularity. Class B RVs are the smallest, and usually easiest to drive of the motorized class. They are typically streamlined and ready to go and well equipped for

their size. Typically sleep between 2 and 4 people.

# **CLASS C**

Families typically love a Class C motorhome. Class C's have sleeping quarters above the driver, and usually one in the middle and a separate bedroom, depending on the floor plan, they can accommodate up to 8 people comfortably.

If you have a good heavy duty truck, a Fifth Wheel might be your best bet

# TRAVEL TRAILERS

Travel trailers are in the towable class. There are many sizes, and options. Slides can make a travel trailer very spacious. Be sure your truck is rated to carry the travel trailer you buy. They are the best of both worlds--self contained, but typically less expensive than a motorized RV.

#### **TOY HAULERS**


